EVENT INFORMATION

1. COMPETITION INFORMATION

- 1.1 Event
- 1.2 VENTURE GAME: THE ROAR OF THE FASTEST SWIMMER
- 1.3 Venue: Enverga University Pool, Lucena City - 50m Pool w/ 10 lanes
- 1.4 W.A rules shall apply in this competition.
- 1.5 One-start Rule shall apply.
- 1.6 This competition will be timed with the LONG Course format of World Aquatics.
- 1.7 Competitions shall be seeded from slowest to fastest.
- 1.8 Only 5 individuals and 1 relay are allowed to be swam by each swimmer

2. GENERAL RULES

VENTURE GAME CHANGER "THE ROAR OF THE FASTEST SWIMMER"

- 2.1 **1 AGE BOND** - is composed of 24 age bond categories: 6yo-under, 7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17-over BOYS AND GIRLS.
 - 2.1.2 Swimmers may swim 5 individual events and one relay.
 - 2.1.3 Awards will be age bond from 6yo-under, 7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17-over
 - 2.1.4 Gold, Silver, and Bronze will be given to the top 3 winners of individual swim and trophies for the Most Outstanding Swimmer.
 - 2.1.5 Only 5 individuals and 1 relay are allowed for each swimmer
 - 2.1.6 The team coach shall undertake the responsibility of ensuring the eligibility of their swimmers competing in the competition. If the organizer finds the swimmer ineligible to swim, the swimmer(s) will be disqualified, and the team may be disqualified and/or fined.
 - 2.1.7 There would be **NO PAGING** for swimmers to report to the Clerk Of Course two events before the exact events. Team's officials are to ensure that their swimmers report to the Call Room prior
 - 2.1.8 Parents and coaches are not allowed in the marshaling or ready bench area.
 - 2.1.9 No one is allowed on the pool deck throughout the competition except the Technical Officials (TO) on duty.
 - 2.1.10 In the event of a need of disciplinary action to be taken against any participant or team, the Organizing Committee shall make a decision and impose punishment as it deems necessary.
 - 2.1.11 While all reasonable precautions will be taken, **The PKWSA** or the Organizing Committee will not be responsible or in any way liable for any death, disability, personal injury, loss of property or any other loss however arising from any cause whatsoever at any time during the course of the competition.
 - 2.1.12 In the event of any question or matter arising at any point which has not been expressly provided for in any of the rules governing this competition, the decision of the Meet manager and referee will be final.
 - 2.1.13 Each participating team shall be responsible for their first aid and medical coverage of their team.
 - 2.1.14 In the event of harsh weather conditions that could cancel the meet, PKWSA reserves the right



not to refund entry fees or any other charges submitted by the teams and/or individuals at the meet, instead the current points of the individuals and teams will be official to announce the winner for MOS and team champion.

- 2.1.15 Coaches will be responsible for the safety of his/her swimmer at all times specially when he/she is in control of the situation.
- 2.1.16 **The SKINS category is the top 10 fastest swimmers in the 200m I.M. After tabulating the fastest 10, the skins category will be executed during lunch break. Since it is coming from the individual medley category, the skins game will be medley where there are four(4) rounds of swimming, ROUND 1 IS WHERE THE ORGANIZER DRAW FOR THE STROKE TO SWIM AFTER THE 1ST ROUND 1 SWIMMER WILL BE ELIMINATED.**
- ROUND 2 IS WHERE THE RANK 1 SWIMMER DRAW FOR THE NEXT STROKE, AFTER 2ND ROUND 1 SWIMMER WILL BE ELIMINATED.**
- ROUND 3 WHERE THE SLOWEST SWIMMER DRAW FOR THE NEXT STROKE, AFTER 3RD ROUND 2 SWIMMERS WILL BE ELIMINATED.**
- ROUND 4 WHERE THE REMAINING STROKE IS TO BE SWAM BY THE REMAINING 6 SWIMMERS, AND THE FIRST 3 SWIMMERS WILL BE AWARDED THE CASH PRIZE AND THE MEDALS.**

3 ENTRY REGULATIONS

- 3.1 Entries Closing Date: **December 6, 2025.**
- 3.2 All participating teams/clubs are required to USE THE WEBSITE FOR INDIVIDUAL ENTRY, OR USE THE TM FORMAT. CLICK HERE TO ENTRY; philippinekillerwhale.com
- 3.3 Entry Report will be distributed to participating teams one day after submission of entry.
- 3.4 Psych Sheets will be sent to participating clubs for verification **on December 10, 2025.**
- 3.5 Any addition/replacement or switching of swimmers are **STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED** for any Individual Events upon release of the Psych Sheet.

4 ENTRIES

- 4.1 Each club is allowed to enter any number of swimmers per event but only the top eight (8) swimmers from each event will be awarded points for the scoring system.
- 4.2 Each swimmer will be allowed to enter **five (5)** individual events and **one (1) relay event.**
- 4.3 **There are 2 types of relays, the 10 under relay which will be awarded medals for the winners and the Open Fastest four relays which will be awarded cash prize and the medals for the winners.**
- 4.4 **The qualification of SKINS category is the top 10 fastest swimmers in the 200m I.M. After tabulating the fastest 10 the skins category will be executed during the lunch break. Since it is individual medley category, the skins game will be a medley where there are four(4) rounds of swimming. And the winners will be awarded cash awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. See gen. rules 2.1.16.**

6 SCORING SYSTEM & AWARD

6.1 Individual Events

7 Team Championship: The team that achieves the highest points in this competition will be crowned as the overall champion.

8 Medals: Medals will be awarded Top 3 swimmers for individual events and Top 3 Teams for relay events.

8.1 Individual Age-BOND Champion

8.2 Individual Age-BOND Champion will be awarded to swimmer(s) based on the number of points for Individual Event ONLY.

8.3 Should there be a tie in points, the number of Gold medals, a count of the number of Silver individual medals will be conducted and followed by the Bronze medals should there be a tie in both the Gold and Silver medals count.

8.4 In the event of a tie in medal count, the swimmer with the number of record breaker or a HIGH WA POINTS IN THE MEET shall be awarded the Individual M.O.

9 DNS/WITHDRAWALS

9.1 Any withdrawal from the ENTRY after the set deadline shall not be possible unless a valid reason of medical certificate must be presented, then 50% of the entry fee can be refunded.

9.2 **NO SHOW** swimmer will be fined **P100.00** for each event.

10 PROTESTS

10.1 All protests shall be considered by the Meet Referee and must be submitted in accordance with the following:

- ♣ In writing, with supporting facts
- ♣ With a deposit of **P1000.00** enclosed



♠ Submitted to the table official, or event Supervisor by the club's Team Leader

♠ Submitted within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the event

10.2 If the Meet Referee rejects the protest, he/she must state the reasons for his/her decision.

10.3 If the protest is rejected, the deposit shall be forfeited by the Organizing Committee. If the protest is upheld, the deposit shall be returned.
